



1 **Guidelines on Scholarships**

2 This regulation addresses the scholarships distributed to members of the association. The aim
3 of the regulation is to continue the tradition of the Turku School of Economics Student Union
4 Support Association (Tuki ry) in awarding scholarships to students of the Turku School of
5 Economics. Scholarships are awarded in accordance with the criteria and procedures defined
6 below.

7 The association's autumn general meeting confirms the total amount of scholarships to be
8 awarded in the form of a budget. The association's board decides on the granting of
9 scholarships.

10 **01 Criteria for Awarding Scholarships**

11 Scholarships are awarded each semester to the best thesis in undergraduate thesis groups at
12 the Turku School of Economics, with one scholarship per group. The best thesis in a thesis
13 group is determined based on the recommendation of the group's supervisor.

14 The primary criterion for selection is the grade received for the thesis. If the primary criterion
15 does not distinguish between members of the group, the supervisor may, at their discretion,
16 use a secondary criterion, such as an evaluation of teamwork within the thesis group. If a
17 distinction still cannot be made, the scholarship may, upon the supervisor's recommendation,
18 be shared between the two best-performing students in the group. The size of the group does
19 not affect the awarding of scholarships.

20 The recipient of the scholarship must be a member of the Turku School of Economics Students'
21 Association at the time the board decides on the distribution of scholarships.

22 **02 Distribution of Scholarships**

23 Scholarships are awarded at the end of the spring and autumn semesters according to the
24 defined criteria. The scholarships are granted based on the recommendation of the thesis
25 group supervisors and by decision of the association's board meeting.

26 Scholarships are delivered to recipients according to the schedule and method determined by
27 the board's decision.
